Juror: Fred Tschida



Fred Tschida is a highly sought after guest lecturer, workshop instructor, artist, and curator. He currently serves as a Professor of Glass and Sculpture/ Dimensional Studies at Alfred University in Alfred, NY, where he resides and also serves as the curator for the Museum of Luminous Phenomena.

As an artist, he has created sculptures and installations in many different media including neon and glass, and has been the subject of many solo shows throughout the United States including an exhibition at the Edwin A. Ulrich Museum of Art. Tschida has lectured and taught workshops at Pilcheck Glass School, Rhode Island School of Design, the Chicago Art Institute, New York Experimental Glass Workshop, Rutgers University, Tulane University, R.I.T, and the University of Minnesota. He is actively involved with the Corning Museum of Glass where he has a piece in their permanent collection, has been a visiting artist, and a juror for their annual publication, *New Glass Review*.

Exhibition & Entry Information

Entry Guidelines

- The exhibit is open to all living artists, amateur or professional, age 16 and over.
- Artists may submit one original work never previously shown in the Central Adirondack Art Show.
- Only recent artwork, executed in the past two years will be allowed.
- Artwork dimensions limited to 48" any direction.
- All 2-dimensional artwork must be appropriately framed with hook eyes and wire for hanging.
- All 3-dimensional artwork must be complete and moveable.

The Arts Guild reserves the right to determine suitability for exhibition. All suitable works will be exhibited.

Entry Categories

The Central Adirondack Art Show is a fine arts exhibit limited to works in the following five categories:

1. Acrylics, Oils or Pastels 2. Watermedia 3. Drawing or Graphics 4. Mixed Media 5. 3-Dimensional Art or Sculpture
Photography, digital art, or craft work is not eligible for this exhibition.

(The Arts Center/Old Forge offers other opportunities for artwork that does not fit in these categories, including an annual themed exhibition, and a craft fair.)

Masters Division - The judge selects the top 10% of the artwork to display in the Ruth Rosenau Gallery as "The Masters Division." Once selected, these pieces are judged against each other; not against the rest of the show.

Delivery, Shipping & Pick Up

Hand delivery of artwork is preferred, although shipping is available through our shipping agent, Wrap City 'N Glue, LLC. There is a fee to ship; please contact Wrap City 'N Glue, LLC, before shipping to them:

- Shipped artwork must arrive by July 5, 2010, with completed entry forms and entry fee. (If shipping, please retain Receipt For Pick-Up section of form.)
- Hand delivered artwork must not arrive at the Arts Center before Saturday, July 3.
- The last day to hand deliver artwork is July 11, from noon - 3 pm.
- The Arts Center will not hold packing materials.
- Pick up begins August 15, between 4:30 and 5:30 pm.
- No artwork will be removed before the close of the exhibit.

Sales of Artwork

- Each entry must be priced or valued for insurance purposes.
- The Arts Guild retains a 30% commission on all entries sold during the Art Show.
- The buyer of the artwork is responsible for shipping costs.

- The Arts Guild of Old Forge, Inc. insures artwork on its premises for the duration of the Art Show.
- It does not insure artwork in transit.
- All artwork unclaimed by September 1 will become property of the Arts Guild.

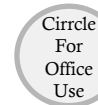

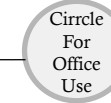
