## Supply List for Arashi, Itajime and Kumo:

- Cloth -this can be cotton or linen cloth, as well as cotton t-shirts or scarves... please prewash all fabrics without fabric softeners. The quantity is very much dependent upon you, but I would say a minimum of 2 yard. If you are bringing scarves or pre-made things 3 or 4 items. You might not want to pre-cut, as different techniques have limitations.
- **Sinew** for tie-dyeing (can be found in the leather section of craft stores). This is not the book binding sinew, which is round. This sinew is flat and stretchy. Dharma Trading is a good source if you can't find it locally.



- Water soluble marker (blue marker or Crayola Washable markers).
- Rubber gloves. They will get stained, so an old pair of dishwashing gloves work.
- Scissors for fabrics and strings.
- Cotton String: anything from pearl cotton to cooking/butcher's twine will work.



• "C" clamps, springs clamps, clothes pins and/or binder clips... the better the clamp, the better your results. I prefer to use "c" clamps but do spring clamps.



• 3 ft piece of 3" or 4" **PVC** pipe (it can be longer or a little shorter).



• Wooden or acrylic **shapes**, should be ½-½" thick. These can be paint stir sticks, rulers, chop sticks, dowels, shapes cut from plywood or acrylic. You can bring different shapes sizes but like Noah... you will need 2 of each shape. Or like socks, it need a matching one.



- **Bucket** (3 to 5 gallon)
- Please bring something to transport your work home in (plastic bags or Rubbermaid containers) and wear clothes that you don't mind getting stained...
